

When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. All of them were filled with the Holy Spirit and began to speak in other languages, as the Spirit gave them ability.

Now there were devout Jews from every nation under heaven living in Jerusalem. And at this sound the crowd gathered and was bewildered, because each one heard them speaking in the native language of each.

Amazed and astonished, they asked, "Are not all these who are speaking Galileans? And how is it that we hear, each of us, in our own native language? Parthians, Medes, Elamites, and residents of Mesopotamia, Judea and Cappadocia, Pontus and Asia, Phrygia and Pamphylia, Egypt and the parts of Libya belonging to Cyrene, and visitors from Rome, both Jews and proselytes, Cretans and Arabs—in our own languages we hear them speaking about God's deeds of power."

Reflection Can you imagine how the disciples must have felt at the beginning of this day? Their friend, Jesus, had promised He would be with them until the end of time, but He had returned to Heaven; all they could do is watch and pray.

Then, all of a sudden, Pentecost happens! Even with everything that they had seen Jesus do over the last 3 years, it must still have been amazing to experience. It was the start of something amazing: the Church. Jesus fulfilled His promise and sent the Holy Spirit to be with them; they were given the courage to go out into the world and share the Good News.

We are the Church and it's our mission to go out into the world, sharing the Good News with those we meet.

ACTIVITIES

Make a Dove

You will need: a paper plate, scissors, pen, glue or tape

Split your plate into thirds, the outside pieces will become the wings and the centre the body.
Cut the dove's head, body and tail from the centre section.
Attach the two wings to your dove's body.
Now you can draw on eyes, a beak and feet.
You could also decorate your dove with feathers if you have them (or anything else you like!)
